SELECTMEN'S MINUTES

April 30, 2020 at the Lyman Town Hall

Chairman Trudell called the meeting to order at 4:25 pm.

The Selectmen and Road Agent Tom Smith met for an update on the possible acquisition of a gently-used Case loader with attachments. This piece of equipment is of interest to the Selectmen as a loader is scheduled to be purchased next year according to the Highway Equipment Replacement Plan. Since the matter first came to the Board's attention last week, the company owning the loader has decided it wants to sell it quickly. After some discussion, Trudell made a motion to authorize Beane to make an offer not to exceed the amount of money in the existing Highway Equipment Capital Reserve Fund, 2nd by Ho-Sing-Loy, all voted in favor. Beane will also look into the cost to transport the machine to Lyman.

Trudell motioned to adjourn the meeting at 5:00 pm, 2nd by Beane, all voted in favor.
