SELECTMEN'S MINUTES

January 4, 2021 at the Town Hall

Chairman Trudell called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

Manifests & Invoices:

The manifests for 12/31/20 and 01/04/21 were authorized and new invoices for future payment were reviewed and initialed.

Meeting Minutes:

Minutes for the December 28th meeting were reviewed. Beane motioned to approve the minutes as written, 2nd by Ho-Sing-Loy, all voted in favor.

Committee/Department Reports & Needs:

- Road Agent Smith reached out to the part time Highway Crew employee, Hubbard about help with necessary work in the summer of 2021.
- Shosa and Carignan discussed safety measures being taken to ensure mail security with the Selectmen. Shosa has been in contact with the Lisbon Postmaster and Carignan has talked with the Carrier that delivers. A secure box will be installed next to the building as soon as the ground thaws enough. Until then Shosa and Carignan have discussed a plan of action with the carrier and Beane to ensure that mail theft does not occur again.
- Landry and the BOS made plans for the upcoming Budget Hearing and Town Meeting. The Budget Hearing will take place at the Town Hall on Tuesday, February 9th. The Town Meeting will take place at the Town Highway Garage on Tuesday, March 9th due to the larger crowd that it usually draws and in an effort to accommodate the larger gathering while still maintaining current restrictions due to COVID 19.

- The BOS reviewed a letter from a taxpayer regarding an Abatement.
