SELECTMEN'S MINUTES

January 11, 2021 at the Town Hall

Manifests & Invoices:

The manifests for 12/31/20 and 01/11/21 were authorized and new invoices for future payment were reviewed and initialed.

Treasurer's Report:

The Treasurer's Report was read showing a balance of \$105,605.89 in the WGSB checking account, \$734,594.21 in the WGSB Insured Cash Sweep (ICS) account. Trudell motioned to approve the Treasurer's report as given, 2nd by Beane, all voted in favor.

Meeting Minutes:

Minutes for the January 4th meeting were reviewed. Beane motioned to approve the minutes as written, 2nd by Ho-sing-loy, all voted in favor.

Permits and Applications:

The following were approved:

Committee/Department Reports & Needs:

- Road Agent Smith discussed the road repair schedule that the Highway Crew will work on in 2021. He will submit a hardcopy of the discussed repair schedule for the BOS. A locked mailbox will be installed within two weeks at the Town Office so that mail can be securely delivered and picked up. Smith and the BOS discussed the Highway Budget and made necessary changes to accommodate upcoming bridge expenses and the need for a new loader in the future.
