# Manifests & Invoices:

The manifests for 04/12/2021 and 04/19/2021 were authorized and new invoices for future payment were reviewed and initialed.

# Treasurer's Report:

The Treasurer's Report was read showing a balance of \$32,220.17 in the WGSB checking account, \$50,000 in the NOW account, and \$264,841.91 in the WGSB Insured Cash Sweep (ICS) account. Trudell motioned to approve the Treasurer's report as given, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ho-sing-loy, all voted in favor.

## Meeting Minutes:

Minutes for the April 5<sup>th</sup> meeting were reviewed. Ho-sing-loy motioned to approve the minutes as written, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Trudell, all voted in favor.

#### Committee/Department Reports & Needs:

• Shosa provided a written update for the training she attended via zoom during the previous week.
