

Selectmen's Minutes

June 9, 2015

Present: Bruce Beane, Jim Trudell, Steve Moscicki, Tom Smith-Road Agent

Chairman Beane called the meeting to order at 7:30 am.

The Selectmen and Road Agent met with representatives of Michie Corp, a company that makes rigid frame bridges. Don Arsenault is in precast sales and Chad Poland is in engineering sales. The purpose of the meeting was to get recommendations and price estimates for replacement of the bridge at the entrance of Mountain Meadows Road.

After some initial discussion about the project, Trudell left the meeting due to a prior commitment. The remaining people proceeded to the Mountain Meadows bridge where measurements were taken and information was gathered so the engineers could develop an estimate for the cost and design of a replacement bridge.

Michie Corp uses precast structures for the building of replacement bridges and the representative felt that they could build a quality structure with less design costs and less building costs than a poured-in-place structure would be. These precast structures would be acceptable to all of the governing authorities concerned.

The Town of Lyman should receive an estimate workup covering all possible costs within the next 2-3 weeks. These people appeared to be hands-on and will sell their engineering work and components directly to the Town without any supplemental costs for middle men.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:20 am.
