The possibility of a necessary warrant article to change from septage to sewage for the 2020 ballot was discussed. More research on the necessity of this change will be done at a later date.

The new 2019 Land Use Regulation Handbooks were handed out to each Planning Board Member as well.

An individual that inquired last week about the subdivision of a property they may be purchasing was advised to attend the Planning Board meeting for additional information. The item was placed on the agenda for this reason but the person was not in attendance. A more in-depth
