Potential buyers of a property located on Hubberton Rd have inquired and discussed different options for upgrading the class 6 portion of the road so that they might be able to access a building site with more ease. The burden of updating a road would fall to the property owner. A rehearing of the 1991 Subdivision that created this lot would be required to change the location of the driveway as that was a condition of the original approval. Any additional information on this matter will be provided at a future date as it becomes available.

The Selectmen have been working with owners of a property located on Poulsen Point Rd that has access issues and would require a variance before a zoning permit for a new house can be granted.

Surveyor Thomas Smith presented a preliminary plan for a Subdivision with a Lot Merger for that was prepared for Elaine D Burkham – Trustee of Elaine D Burkham Revoc Living Trust for properties at 565 Under the Mountain Rd., Map 215 Lot 013 & 014-001containing approximately 307.84. The plan will transfer 15.0 acres from the larger lot to create a 20.0 acre lot and a 287.84 acre lot. There were no major concerns noted.
